

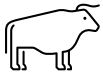
Pearl Ann Adams Promotion Fund – Reimbursement Form

Pearl Ann was a lifetime member of the Colorado Cattlewomen, Northeast Cattlewomen and the Weld County Cattlewomen. She helped her mother, Helen Budin, start the National Beef Cook-off in 1974 and chaired the Colorado Beef cook-off for two years. In 2006 she was recognized as “cattlegirl of the year” by the Colorado Cattlewomen.

She was active in many organizations during in lifetime, from volunteering at the Sterling Regional Medical Center, to being an active member of the Logan County Historical Society. She sang in her church choir for a total of 60 years. Her unselfishness of volunteerism has led her family to graciously endow funds to keep her name alive amongst the Colorado Cattlewomen.
